 - PBIS Implementation with a focus on belonging, relationships, and cultural responsiveness (RC Houses program)
 - Continued implementation of the Just One program for mentorship and support of individual students
 - Continued monitoring and support through SST

Discipline Strategy:

Statement of Commitment: We commit to creating a positive school culture that prioritizes healthy relationships and grows a culture of belonging so that students will experience less exclusionary discipline as evidenced by overall suspension rates.

Action Steps:

- Professional learning with school-based staff on how to grow a culture of Belonging (implementing new school wide PBIS strategies - Ron Clark Houses - this school year)
- Provide professional learning around feedback strategies and connect it to the RC House program.
