

Related Arts Primary Canvas Grades

As we approach the end of our 2nd quarter of instruction, it is important to remember that Canvas represents only a small portion of the learning continuum that happens in elementary school, especially in primary Related Arts Classes.. While there are "grades" that parents may see in a certain subject, please know that the teachers are using many different avenues to evaluate student learning. There is classroom participation, student observation and questioning as well as evidence of learning behaviors in the classroom that all work together to determine the actual grade a child may receive. It is also important to remember that at the primary level, we are working to build a basis for learning that develops at different times for different students. The score you may see in Canvas only represents a snapshot of the journey of learning and is based on percentages that are connected to but not absolute in our primary grading system.. We will evaluate our youngest student skills as independent (I), with assistance (W) or not yet apparent (N). The percentages you may see are NOT connected to letter grades at the primary level.

If any of your child's teachers have concerns about your child's learning, they will be in touch with you before the report card is ever issued.

If you have any questions, please reach out to your child's related arts teacher.

If you were unable to upload the required documentation during the online registration process, the registering staff will discuss with you a process for scanning or emailing your required documents to the school.
