

In-person Commitment

On January 21, Governor Hogan shared his expectations for Maryland schools to change to a hybrid format by March 1. On January 26, the Howard County Board of Education voted to direct the Superintendent and staff to implement a phased-in approach to opening schools. Information was sent to you by email on Thursday, January 28. Please be sure to complete the survey indicating your instructional preference by February 5. Hybrid Model - Concurrent teaching/In-person Instruction

As the HCPSS continues to communicate with the overall Howard County community, we will provide meaningful updates regarding what specific plans/schedules/safety precautions look like for our HSES families at home and in the building. We want to make sure we provide the most accurate information to you in a timely manner. This change is new to us, and we are in the early planning phase to help implement this change according to the timeline. As we learn more information, we will share the changes required to implement the Hybrid model successfully in multiple ways. We will share information through Google Meets (Feb. 18th-next Community Conversation), email, and this newsletter. Our goal is to provide the best

educational opportunities for our students regardless if they are in-person at school, remain entirely virtual, or some sort of hybrid arrangement.

Family File

This is also a great time to double check that your child's Family File is updated. We must have updated emergency contact information for your child with in-person instruction beginning in the coming weeks. To update your Family File, sign in to HCPSS Connect. You will need to click through each of the pages, for each one of your children, and review all of the information in order to verify it is up to date. If you have any questions about your child's Family File, please contact the front office at 410-313-2550.

Report Cards

As we prepare our Q2 report cards, you may recall that due to the challenges with adjusting to virtual learning, the Howard County Public School System made some temporary changes to grading that may have been reflected on your child's Q1 Report Card. Specifically, students in primary grades earned either an I (Independent) or W (With assistance) if they had engaged in synchronous instruction, and students in intermediate grades received A, B or C grades if they had engaged in synchronous instruction.

As was mentioned at the time, those changes were put in place for 1st quarter only. For Q2 SY20-21 grades, teachers will assign the appropriate grade based on student performance. In the primary grades that means students may receive an I (Independent), W (With Assistance), or N (Not Apparent at this Time). In the intermediate grades, students may receive any grade from A to E.


