Reminders about Bus Transportation

If you have not already done so, please use the <u>bus locator link</u> to identify your child/children's bus number, bus stop and estimated travel times. Once you click the link above, you will enter your child/children's grade, and your home address. The bus number, bus stop location, and pick-up/ drop off time will be listed.

Students who receive specialized transportation though their IEPs will be contacted by their bus driver with bus numbers and pick-up/ drop off times.

For all bus riders, please plan to arrive at the bus stop 10-15 minutes early the first two weeks of school, to allow the bus the flexibility needed to pick up and drop off all students. Additionally, we ask for your patience as the bus drivers are learning new routes, and a lot of our students are learning the process for riding the bus. As a result, there may be instances where the bus is arriving later than anticipated specifically during the first couple weeks of school.

Kindergarten students will be let off the bus last at the start of the school year and walked to the cafeteria to be picked up by their teachers.
