As we move into the school year, there will be some assessments and instructional tasks that require students to use headphones. We are asking that our families send in headphones with their students. Please label them with your student's name. Headphones can remain at school for consistent availability. Thank you for your support!

<u> 1st Grade Chromebooks - Please Return:</u>

If you were a family that had students attending HCPSS last year, then your child received a Chromebook. All 1st grade students are required to return their Chromebooks at this time. In the future, 1st graders will receive another Chromebook. However, at this time, families should bring or send their 1st grade student's Chromebook in as soon as possible to be scanned and re-assigned.

Volunteers - Vaccine and Testing Information:

Will school volunteers who work with students be required to show proof of vaccination or testing?

Effective Monday, Sept. 20, all volunteers who enter HCPSS schools to interact with or support students must provide proof of vaccination status or a negative COVID-19 test (within seven days of the current date) to school administration when they check in at the front office.

Volunteers must be masked regardless of their vaccination status. Volunteers may be able to access the free weekly testing offered within school and office buildings, subject to availability of tests. Volunteers should <u>perform a COVID-19 health check</u> every day before coming to an HCPSS building and should stay home if they are experiencing any symptom(s) associated with any communicable disease.

Additionally, all <u>volunteers must complete a Confidentiality Training Course</u> about protecting the privacy of our students, staff, and schools, and the <u>Child Abuse and Neglect Training</u> about reporting any suspicion of child abuse or neglect to Howard County Department of Social Services.

Towson University Free Tutoring Program

TOWSON COLLEGE OF EDUCATION



We understand the impact the shift to virtual learning has had on all students, but in particular our underserved student populations. Therefore, the TU College of Education has established the COE TUtors program.

COE TUtors is a **free** online tutoring program for K-12 students in Maryland. The tutors are teacher candidates at Towson University. With support and guidance from faculty members, they will **design lessons** for each tutoring session based on students' needs and will provide families with **feedback on student progress**.

The program will offer:



tutoring in specific content areas (math, reading, writing)



additional support for students with exceptionalities English language support



Tutoring sessions will occur weekly and last 30-60 minutes.



All tutoring sessions will occur via Zoom. You can learn more about the policies for tutoring sessions on the COE TUtors site.

Interested families can apply for the Fall semester starting on **September 12th**. The application form will be posted on the <u>COE TUtors site</u>.



COE TUtors

COE TUtors es un programa gratuito de tutorías en línea para estudiantes de grados K-12 de Maryland. Los tutores son estudiantes de educación en la Universidad Towson. Information Previously Shared

HSES Synchronous Quarantine Support (For Canvas Homepage or as a letter for you to send if needed)

- All students in prekindergarten through grade 5 have been/will be provided a packet
 of grade level instructional materials that cover all content areas including related arts.
 (Students in the PreK program are to receive their instructional packets on September
 2, 2021, and students in grades kindergarten through 5 on or before September 10,
 2021.) The packets are only to be used in the event a student needs to quarantine.
 These packets also will be available via Canvas. The tasks that students complete from
 the packet will not be used as an assessment or counted toward any part of the
 students' report card grade.
- Students may also access instructional materials via their teacher's Canvas page. If a student does not possess a device, one will be assigned by the school.
- Students may participate in two weekly 20 minute virtual check-ins with their teacher(s) to ask questions or receive help with reading/language arts and mathematics asynchronous assignments. Scheduling instructions will be provided by

the school.

• Beginning in mid-September, students will have access to virtual tutoring services via the Evening School program.

Grading:

Most grades will be posted through our teacher Canvas pages. However, please know that some grades that teachers collect are observational and anecdotal. As a result, Canvas will not reflect all grades collected. Should a teacher have any concerns, they will inform the parent prior to the quarterly report card.

<u>Chromebook Obligations:</u> Beginning Monday, September 13, HCPSS will charge families for lost, stolen, or damaged devices per the following parameters.

- Families will be charged for any devices that are lost, stolen or damaged while in their care.
- If devices are lost, stolen or damaged during school hours and in the school building, school administrators will conduct an investigation to determine if the incident was the result of neglect on the part of the assigned student.

<u>Chromebook Expectations</u>: Please continue to remind students and families that it is our expectation that students in grades 2-12 bring the Chromebook that was issued to them to school daily. Schools have a limited number of devices to loan to students. Information related to <u>HCPSS technology and devices</u> is online and may be shared with families.
