

Each year, the Howard County Public School System partners with the Maryland Partnership for Prevention to bring flu immunizations into our schools for students and staff. This year, they will also be offering the latest Covid vaccine (Moderna.) The clinic will be held on the stage on the morning of Monday, October 16th. If you would like to be vaccinated against the flu and/or Covid at this clinic.

YOU MUST REGISTER USING THE LINK BELOW. MPP will not accept any paper consents on clinic day.

YOU MUST PROVIDE YOUR INSURANCE INFORMATION, as MPP will bill your insurance for the vaccines. You will not be required to pay anything.

Absences over 10 days

Local Discretion Days

In accordance with Policy 9010 Attendance, if students are traveling or participating in other activities, principals may grant up to three days of excused discretionary absences. Please find the local discretionary day form <u>HERE</u>.

Work is not provided to students who are withdrawn from school. Below are reminders from Policy 9010:

Policy 9010 Implementation Procedures: Attendance

Students with unlawful absences of ten (10) consecutive school days or more will be withdrawn from school and may be allowed to re-enroll, provided they meet enrollment requirements, upon their return. Upon expiration of the 10-day window, the student will be withdrawn and the date of the exit will be the first day after the last day of attendance. Teachers will not be required to provide make-up work during this time of absence. For these absences to be considered as lawful, parents will need to exercise the option outlined in Section III. of these procedures.

Policy 9010: Attendance

Make-up Work

1. A student may make up work missed due to lawful absence and receive a recorded grade in accordance with Policies 8010 Grading and Reporting: Prekindergarten through Grade 5 and 8020 Grading and Reporting: Middle and High School.

Students cannot make up missed assignments due to an unexcused absence. No grades are given for make-up work.

Policy 3060

In order to support privacy of all students and staff, and ensure implementation of HCPSS Policy 8080 and Policy 3060 (see linked form) while also supporting student's communication and safety needs—the school administrator will require the completion of this <u>form</u> before allowing any student to use certain types of personal technology, assistive technology, and/or tracking devices at school.
