Solar Eclipse Visible in Howard County

On Monday, April 8, 2024, a partial solar eclipse will be visible in Howard County, Maryland. This partial eclipse will begin at 2:05 pm, with maximum coverage at 3:21 pm, and end around 4:35 pm. We will be dismissing during the solar eclipse.

Safety during a solar eclipse is important. Please review this information with your child(ren) to ensure safety at home:

- <u>Never</u> look directly at the Sun, especially during a solar eclipse.
- It is dangerous to look directly at the Sun and can cause permanent damage to the eyes.
- Do not look at the Sun through sunglasses, telescope, or binoculars.

We encourage you and your family to read more about <u>solar eclipses</u> and <u>safety</u> and enjoy experiencing this rare, exciting phenomenon.
